


### WHY HIRE A CAT SITTER?

During Holidays when my schedule is busier, I will still be with your cat for at least 30 minutes during each visit.

If you have other little pets such as birds, fish, gerbils, hamsters or rabbits, I will happily take care of them as well. I'll also water your plants, if you have any.

If your cat seems to be sick, or anything seems to be wrong, I will notify you immediately and will take your cat to your vet if you think it's necessary. In case you are not reachable, I will use my own good judgment and made the decision.

And if you'd like, I will be happy to call or e-mail you while you are away with reports of how your cat is doing.
